
park or have been a long time resident, being involved with this group will give you a chance to meet new people. Help is always needed and very appreciated.

Being on the Board can be time consuming and often a thankless job, so at this time I would like to say Thank you Gretchen. Your efforts are appreciated.



Elections for the board will be here before you know it. Nomination forms will be sent out May 12. As you are aware the proxy system has been changed so that each and every lot owner will get a ballot and be able to vote in the election. After nominations are received all nominees will be contacted by the board to make sure they want to run in the elections. This is a good time to make sure your phone number is current. 
