Kenneth E. Ginter, age 69 of 122 N. Main St., Elkton, passed away Wednesday, Dec. 26 at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe following an apparent heart attack.

He was born Aug. 3, 1910 in Elkton. On May 16, 1936, he was united in marriage to Margaret Magwood in Clayton. Mr. Ginter owned Ginter Electric in 1934 until his retirement in 1975, when he sold the business to his sons.
