

THE DISTRICT REQUIRED FORM

- All Pasco County Public Schools teams must have it in order to compete
- ∅ one per team member
- O complete with all signatures
- You should have turned it in today; if not, contact Freda and let her know when it's coming and how – WELL BEFORE tournament day.

What the well-prepared coach needs to know: • Paperwork – 4 copies of everything (2 sets)

- Outside assistance form will be compared to online registration roster.
- ⊘ Division 1: coach can scribe paperwork.
- Division 2 & 3: kids have to complete it on their own.

STYLE FORM

- Form MUST match the categories given in the problem.
- O Form MUST specify the aspect being scored.
- ✓ Example: "Creative use of a trash item" may be how it's written in the problem.
- On the form the team may write: "Creative use of coffee grounds."
- O Be specific in free choice items. "Backdrop" would include front, back, top, and bottom, and all scene changes.



- ⊘ Primary Teams have a special style form.
- Required lists for problems 1, 2, 3, 5, AND primary – copies available online at national and regional sites (and here tonight).
- O Teams need at least 4 copies of the required list to turn in at staging – again, BE SPECIFIC.

What the well-prepared coach needs to know

- If you have to change the worker you can. We don' need to know. Make sure the new person is of the same category as the original: adults only can be door monitor, strong for trailer packing, etc.
- O Tell whoever is now serving the shift the name of the original worker, so they can check in as that person.
- ⊘ SOMEONE has to fulfill the assignment or the team receives the penalty.

What the well-prepared coach needs to know: Hospitality Assignment – You picked it up today. What you bring is what you and our judges eat. Well-fed judges are happy judges. Happy judges are good. Unhappy judges are less focused, more likely to miss subtle humor, and more inclined to frown. Get the connection?




THE TOURNAMENT



- TAKE THEIR CELL PHONES & HOLD THEM TILL THEY'RE OUT OF SPONTANEOUS.










