NRHW Alarm will then send out an all call page for team members to respond to the incident.

****NRHW Alarm shall provide a call back to the Alarm office needing the response once team members are enroute and provide an estimated time of arrival or ETA.***



Hazardous Materials Response

Activating Agency:

Contact NRHW Alarm at **(817) 281-1000** and request a Level I or Level II Hazardous Materials response as directed by Incident Command. Provide the NRHW Alarm office the information above and any additional incident details that might be available.

Level I Response:

NRHW Alarm will dispatch HazMat 22 and they shall contact Roanoke Dispatch to send HazMat 66 as well. North Richland Hills will also send one engine company and their Battalion Chief as well.

Level II Response:

NRHW Alarm will complete all the tasks under Level I Response above and request a HazMat Technician response from the following cities: Bedford, Euless, Richland Hills, Southlake, Trophy Club, Watauga, and Westlake.
