License to Carry (LTC) Practice: These are held every other Thursday night from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. Introducing this month, a daytime LTC practice on Tuesday 19th at 9:00 AM. The participants get the opportunity to practice drawing from their concealment with their everyday carry pistols. All participants are closely monitored to provide a safe and fun atmosphere. There are multiple scenarios and barricades to practice different aspects of defending oneself if the situation ever presents itself.

New Daytime LTC Practice was introduced in October and will continue for those who are unable to make the evening Practices. The next one will be December 21st at 9:00.

International Defensive Pistol Association (IDPA): Practices and holds their events every other Wednesday starting at 6:00 PM. Our IDPA nights offer a safe environment to improve or enhance your gun handling and shooting skills. A perfect opportunity to increase your confidence in daily carry and self-defense. These practices and events are open to ANY safe shooter, you do not need to be an IDPA member to participate.

[Baldwin Shooting: A Calamity of Preventable Gun Safety Errors](#) by John Crump

This month's article comes to us from ammoland.com. I will spotlight a little bit of the article, please click on the link above to read the full story. More information has come to light since this story came out and I assume more information will continue to be released.

"The lack of safety on the set was so much of a concern that the crew of Rust quit in protest over the conditions. The producers, including executive producer Alec Baldwin, allegedly cut corners to save money. After the crew left, Baldwin hired a local replacement crew and moved forward with the production as if nothing ever happened."

"Another point of concern with the filming of Rust was the chain of custody of the firearm in question. The gun was handed to Baldwin by assistant director Dave Halls. The assistant director told Baldwin that the revolver was "cold," meaning that it was unloaded. Baldwin didn't check the gun for himself. According to Zanoloff, during the filming of a movie, the only people that should touch the firearm is the armorer and the actor."

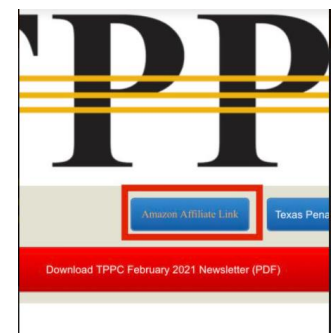
"Baldwin is the executive producer of Rust. He is responsible for all actions on the set. He could be found negligent, especially because he didn't check the gun and did not handle the previous incidents of the lack of firearm safety on the set. Legal experts AmmoLand News consulted said that Baldwin and Gutierrez-Reed could be charged with manslaughter. The legal experts believe that a civil suit against everyone involved, and the production company will be coming soon."



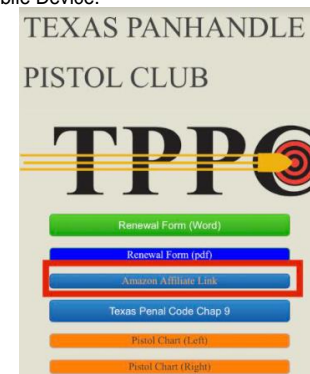

“Spotting Malicious Websites If things seem too good to be true, they probably are! Here are some ways to spot a fake online retailer of reloading components:

1) If a retailer has items in stock that no one else does (and at lower prices) – take caution!

2) Do an internet search to check whether the website is legitimate.
3) If the website has broken English, or doesn't “read right”, take caution, dig deeper.
4) If the website doesn't take credit cards, don't do business with them.

Reporting Fraud
If you've been taken advantage of by one of these websites, report it immediately!

One option for reporting fraud is the [FTC online fraud reporting tool](#). Stay safe!”

Dry Firing – [Next Level Training SIRT Pistol](#)

SIRT stands for **Shot Indicating Resetting Trigger**. The SIRT Pistol comes in models that simulate an AR-15, a Sig P320, a compact pocket pistol, a Glock 17/22, or a Smith & Wesson M&P. The manufacturer, Next Level Training, is not associated with the aforementioned gun manufacturers. (Following information it from their website)

Train more often, more effectively in a more practical environment, your home. The SIRT Training Pistol is designed for high-volume self-diagnostic training with no set up and safe sustainable training. Make better use of your live fire rounds when you've already got hundreds of reps in your house.

Not everybody's set up to be as efficient as possible on the range. What's your goal when you get to the range? What I find is when you go to the range to shoot, some training may occur, but most of the time it's for fun. A prime example of this would be when that magazine runs dry on a drill. Instead of quickly reloading and getting back into it, people immediately stop and start talking to their buddies. Pay attention next time you're at the range. How many people reload their firearm as soon as it goes dry? The answer is not very many. Efficiency is very, very important. The habits you build at the range will show up in the way you perform.

NSSF.ORG -> ROBERT FRANCIS 'BETO' O'ROURKE, AND HIS GUN BANS, STUMBLES INTO GOVERNOR'S CONTEST

"Some people in politics just can't take the message from voters. Failed U.S. Senate candidate and failed Democratic presidential candidate Robert Francis "Beto" O'Rourke is sitting at 0-2 down in the count and announced a 2022 gubernatorial campaign.

NSSF-Adjusted NICS Background Checks for October 2021

Excerpt from The Gun Bulletin (<https://thegunbulletin.com/2021/11/03/nssf-adjusted-nics-background-checks-for-october-2021/>)

"The NSSF-adjusted October 2020 National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) figure of 1,427,264 is a decrease of 19.3 percent compared to the October 2020 NSSF-adjusted NICS figure of 1,769,553. For comparison, the unadjusted October 2021 FBI NICS figure 2,577,913 reflects a 21.1 percent decrease from the unadjusted FBI NICS figure of 3,268,909 in October 2020."
