- 11. The Pope is:
 - the spiritual leader of the Church
 - the successor of Saint Peter, the first Pope.

- 15. The liturgical color, white, symbolizes joy. It is used at Christmas and Easter.

- 18. The liturgical color, purple, symbolizes penance. It is used during Lent and Advent.
- 19. Lent is a special time to prepare our hearts for Jesus.
- 20. The Stations of the Cross is a special Lenten devotion.
- 21. Jesus celebrated the Last Supper with his apostles on Holy Thursday.
- 22. Judas betrayed Jesus on Holy Thursday night.
- 23. Jesus rose from the dead on Easter Sunday.
- 24. Pentecost is fifty days after Easter Sunday.
- 25. Mary is the Mother of the Church.
- 26. The Rosary is a special prayer of devotion to Mary.
- 27. The traditional color used to honor Mary is blue.
- 28. Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist are called the Sacraments of Initiation.
- 29. Statues, icons, palms, ashes and rosaries are sacramentals.
