2019/2020 Application guidelines:

Purpose:

To advance the knowledge and science of die casting and the utilization of die casting through education and research.

Eligibility

To be eligible for a NADCA Chapter 3 scholarship, the applicant must meet all of the following requirements:

- **Must have a high school diploma or equivalent and be enrolled and attending a 2 or 4 year college or university or Technical school.**
- **The student must be enrolled in Engineering, Industrial or Business curriculum.**
- **Applicant must live, work or attend school within the boundaries of NADCA Chapter 3.**

Funding for the Scholarship:

Funding for the scholarship(s) will be at the discretion of the NADCA Chapter 3 Board of Directors.

Application for Scholarship

Any person meeting the outlined criteria and who is interested in applying for a NADCA Chapter 3 scholarship must have their application submitted to the chapter's education committee by November 1st 2019.

Selection Criteria:

The following items will be considered during the selection process for a "Chapter 3 Scholarship:

1. School the applicant is attending.
2. Course of study being pursued applicable to the die casting industry.
3. Is the applicant currently working? For Whom? How many hours per week?
4. Current or prior work experience.
5. Extracurricular activities.
6. Other circumstances which show commitment to the "Die Casting Industry".

Please provide a resume of your work experience, part or full time.
