Good afternoon from Midway Nursing Home

This is an update from yesterday's COVID notification. There are no new positive cases for either residents or staff. Per NYS & NYC DOH guidance and out of an abundance of caution, the entire facility is quarantined for two weeks. The two residents who tested positive remain asymptomatic and no other residents are displaying signs or symptoms of COVID as of this notification.

All residents are being closely monitored and are on both droplet and contact isolation precautions through the end of the quarantine period. Staff will be utilizing full PPE for every resident encounter.

Resident movement is limited to their rooms and enhanced cleaning measures are continuing.
