Parent Handbook Summary

DAILY SCHOOL SCHEDULE

Students should enter the building and proceed directly to their homeroom beginning at 8:00am. Students need to be under adult supervision at all times. Students not under direct adult supervision are to report to the Morning Care room. All students must remain on school property from the time they arrive until the regularly scheduled day is complete. Any exception to the rule must come through written request from the parents with final approval through the school office.

DRESS CODE

DRESS CODE: *GIRLS (K-8)* Khaki pants, skort, skirt (knee length)
Hunter green knit shirt (long or short sleeves)
White ONLY tennis shoes (white shoe laces)
Under shirts and tank tops must be white
White, gray or hunter green socks, tights, or knee highs
Hunter green, gray or white cardigan sweater
St. Bridget hunter green or gray sweatshirt
*No bell bottom/flare jeans, corduroy, carpenter or cargo pants.
*Shirts must be tucked in during the school day.

BOYS (K-8) Khaki pants, hunter green knit shirt (long or short sleeves)
White ONLY tennis shoes (white shoe laces)
White plain t-shirts only under polo shirts
White socks
Hunter green, gray or white cardigan
St. Bridget hunter green or gray sweatshirt
6th, 7th & 8th grade Only – White dress shirt with appropriate neck tie (Optional)
*No jeans, corduroy, carpenter or cargo pants.
*Shirts must be tucked in during the school day.

GYM UNIFORM Green St. Bridget gym shorts (purchased from school)
Gray St. Bridget tee-shirt (purchased from school)
White socks & athletic shoes (white shoe laces)
St. Bridget green sweatshirt or hoodie (purchased by school office)
Plaid St. Bridget pants (purchased by school office)
*Students must have all white school or athletic shoes in order to participate in gym class.

NOTES:

BELT Belts must be worn with pants and/or walking shorts that have loops. Excluding Kindergarten and First grade. Belts are part of the daily uniform and should be a plain color. They are not to be worn as a fashion statement.

- HAIRCUT** Unusual, drastic, or fad haircuts/styles may not be worn in school. Hair color is to be natural (not dyed, tinted, highlighted or streaked). Length of hair may not exceed the collar for boys and must be cut behind the ears.
- JEWELRY** Girls may wear one pair of earrings, post only.
Earrings are to be worn by girls only.
Boys & Girls may wear one watch & one religious necklace (tucked in).
No body piercing except in ears.
No Bracelets
No rings
- MAKEUP** Not to be worn or used. This includes concealer & cover-up.
Nail polish is not to be worn.
- SOCKS** Must cover ankles; no logos.

COOL DOWN UNIFORM

- During the months of August, September, October, April, May, and June only.
- Girls:** Khaki walking shorts (knee length)
Hunter green knit shirt (long or short sleeves)
White or Hunter green socks and athletic shoes
- Boys:** Khaki walking shorts (knee length)
Hunter green knit shirt (long or short sleeves)
White socks and athletic shoes

NON-UNIFORM DAYS: Occasionally there will be days where students are permitted to be out of uniform by “dressing up” (Picture Day, Graduation, etc.) “dressing down” (reward, charity event, etc.). On these days students must follow certain rules:

- *Tank, sleeveless or narrow strap tops may not be worn.
- *Tops that have low-cut necklines or that expose bare midriff when sitting, stretching, bending, stooping, etc. may not be worn.
- *Skirts and/or dresses may not be mini dresses
- *Girls skirts and shorts must be appropriate length, no shorter than fingertip and boys’ shorts must be no longer than the knees.
- *Writing on clothing may not contain vulgar and/or inappropriate wording, pictures, gestures.
- *No sandals (including flip flops).
- *Beachwear type clothing is prohibited.
- *No make up or nail polish.
