#### REDEEMER LUTHERAN CHURCH

#### Ministry Partnership with Concordia Lutheran Church of Pickerel Lake

At the Annual Meetings of both congregations, the congregation members voted to move forward with a 6 month trial of sharing in a ministry partnership. This means that Pastor Kristi will be the part-time Pastor for each congregation. Splitting her time 50-50 with both congregations. Each church retains its own identity and remains its own congregation. Each will continue to have its own Council, and many of the church programs and functions will continue the same.

This partnership will become effective on March 1st. The Church Councils and leaders will be meeting with Pastor Kristi during the month of February to finalize the details for this partnership, including looking at time change for worship services. A current suggestion for Sunday worship time change for Redeemer is moving from 9:00 a.m. start time to 8:45 a.m. with Sunday School moving from 10:15 a.m. start time to 10:00 a.m. We will also be looking at how to provide Lenten services beginning in March. The Councils want to explore ways to share together in ministry as well, like Confirmation classes and Youth Group.



#### March is FoodShare Month in Minnesota

This March, Redeemer Lutheran joins food shelves, faith communities, businesses, and organizations across Minnesota in acting to end hunger and food insecurity.

The Alden Area Food Shelf will be participating in the Minnesota FoodShare March Campaign during the month of March.

It is the only annual statewide food and fund drive of its kind in Minnesota. During the month of March 300 food shelves around the state come together with congregations, businesses, community groups, schools and others to restock food shelves to help feed our neighbors in need. Every dollar collected locally goes directly to the Alden Area Food Shelf to purchase food.

The donations of money and pounds of food collected by the food shelf, and the number of clients served locally will determine the percentage of dollars Alden Area Food Shelf will receive from Minnesota FoodShare.

During the worship services at Redeemer during March you will see Mission Envelopes in our pews. Please use these envelopes for your donations. 
