To "honor" means to supporting financially.

**Exodus 20:12** — "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the Lord your God gives you."

- A. This commandment was given first to the adults.
  - 1. The target audience were the adults:
  - 2. "*Honor*" is a common word meaning "to hold in high regard".
  - 3. **The promise** of a prolonged life in the land is given.
- B. By extension, this commandment is passed down to children.

**Ephesians 6:1–3** — "<sup>1</sup> Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <sup>2</sup> Honor your father and mother (which is the first commandment with a promise), <sup>3</sup> so that it may be well with you, and that you may live long on the earth."

- II. We are to honor our parents in their old age by making sure they are taken care of financially.
  - A. Jesus said that parental support comes ahead of gifts to the temple.

Matt. 15:4 "For God said, 'Honor your father and mother,' and, 'He who speaks evil of father or mother, let him be put to death.' 5 "But you say, 'Whoever shall say to his father or mother, "Anything of mine you might have been helped by has been given to God," 6 he is not to honor his father or his mother.' And thus you invalidated the word of God for the sake of your tradition.

1 Timothy 5:3-8 -"Honor widows who are widows indeed; 4 but if any widow has children or grandchildren, let them first learn to practice piety in regard to their own family, and to make some return to their parents; for this is acceptable in the sight of God. .... 7 Prescribe these things as well, so that they may be above reproach. 8 But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith, and is worse than an unbeliever.

- 1. Context clearly indicates that "those of his own household" is referring to widowed parents (not referring to children).
- 2. Real godliness is taking care of our parents financially as they took care of us in our childhood.

  - B. Telling your parents of your commitment is important.
  - C. Be prepared to take care of your spouse's parents.
    - 1. Wisdom would say to marry someone who has a love for your parents.
  - **D. God's Promise:** He will see your piety and pour blessings, provision and protection in your direction.
