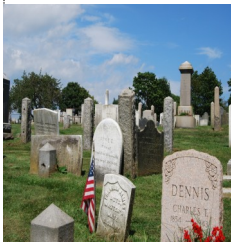

## Confirmation Preparation

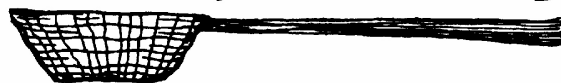
