OVERVIEW

This program prepares students to function as certified Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT). Emergency Medical Technicians operate in a variety of settings from public emergency services, private industry and health care facilities. EMT employment varies from community to community and is considered a growing occupation within the Allied Health professions. Training topics include the skills necessary to provide emergency medical care at a basic life support level with a fire, ambulance, or other specialized service.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The following materials must be submitted:

- ☐ Completed application form
- ☐ A typed or written essay (300 – 500 words, double spaced) addressing the following topic:
Why do you want to be an EMT and why should you be selected for this scholarship?
- ☐ One letter of reference or recommendation from a teacher, coach, or other adult who is not an immediate relative.
- ☐ Interview with member(s) of selection committee.
