MRA PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Cynthiana Board of Commissioners held a public hearing on May 1, 2018 at 5:00 P.M. for the purpose of obtaining citizen comments regarding the proposed use of Municipal Road Aid Funds for the year beginning July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. The hearing was held in the Harrison County Board of Education Board Room located at 308 Webster Avenue, Cynthiana, Kentucky. Mayor Smith declared the hearing open.

A roster of attendees is hereto attached and made a part hereof.

City Clerk Hutchison supplied everyone in attendance with a list of proposed streets to be paved and funds available. A copy of the funds available and the proposed streets are hereto attached and made a part hereof.

Commissioner Griggs presented the 2017-2018 proposed MRA project noting that the exact cost of this paving is not known at this time since bids have not been received. The City will include as many of the proposed streets as possible based on availability of funds and bid results. Commissioner Griggs noted any street with water or sewer line replacement scheduled will not be paved until the work is completed.

Mayor Smith asked for comments.

Mayor Smith commented that W. Mill Street from Locust to Poplar will have another home constructed soon, the ground breaking is this month. It would probably be better to pave after construction of the homes is complete.

The Commissioner also stated that Bridge Street is in bad shape as well and hope that it can be included in the paving.

Being no further comments and no public comments Mayor Smith declared the hearing closed.
