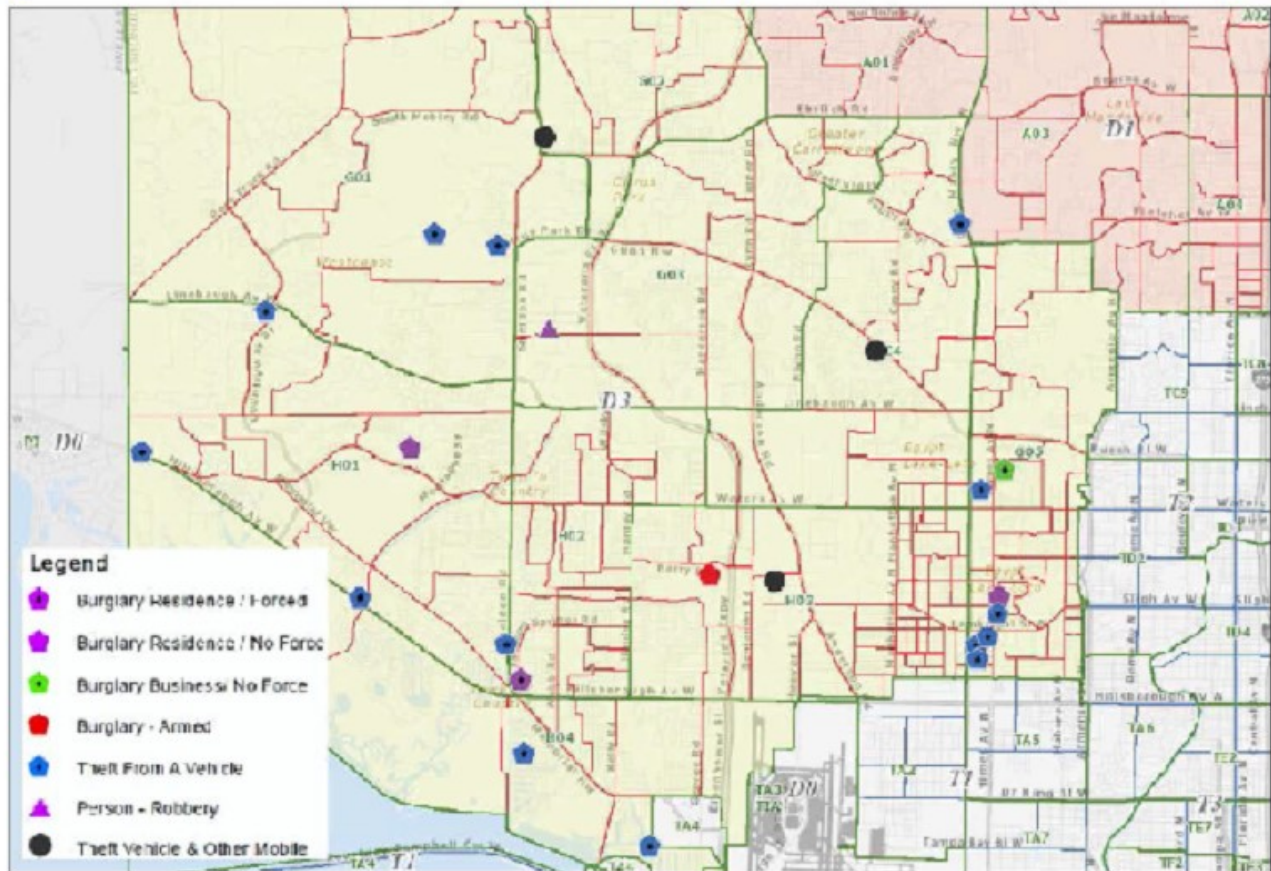

General District III Notes

- Residential burglaries down 40% from last week
- Vehicle burglaries down 34% from last week
- Stolen vehicles down 30% from last week

Community Resource Deputy Area 1 (Deputy Hugh Alter)
Northwest/Odessa Area (including Keystone and Westchase)

- There were two vehicle burglaries reported in this area. Both were within the Fawn Ridge subdivision off of Sheldon Road and both involved unlocked doors.

Community Resource Deputy Area 2 (Deputy Jeff Carson)
Carrollwood/Citrus Park Area (including Lutz and Carrollwood Village)

- There was one "Felony Lane" style vehicle burglary reported in the area. It took place outside the Jasmine Thai restaurant on Dale Mabry Hw. While the victim was inside.

Community Resource Deputy Area 3 (Deputy Ashely Lindeman)
Town and Country/Baycrest Area (including Dana Shores and Tampa Shores)

- There were five vehicle burglaries reported in this area. Four of the five were the result of unlocked doors.
- There was one residential burglary reported in this area. It took place in the Countryway area and was the result of an unlocked/open garage door.

Community Resource Deputy Area 4 (Deputy Chris Cullinan)
Town and Country Area (including Twelve Oaks and Pat Acres)

- There were two residential burglaries reported in this area. Both were the result of forced entry (broken or pried windows/doors).

Community Resource Deputy Area 5 (Master Deputy Art Peralta)
Egypt Lake/Leto Area (including Twin Lakes and Alexander Park area)

- There were five vehicle burglaries reported in the area. All occurred near the area of Himes Avenue and three were the result of unlocked doors.
