### FIFTH SUNDAY ORDINARY TIME



Sickness, disease of body and mind and disharmony in nature are part of the human condition and a sign of the fallen state of sinful humanity. The readings this week call upon us to consider the occurrence of evil in its various forms in our individual and community lives and to look past the evil itself, to the remedy for all evil in our lives. This remedy is, of course, Jesus who came to free us from evil in all its forms. Job presents the picture of a good man who suffers and expresses his confusion and pain in a lament to God. The Gospel presents the healing brought by Jesus as the solution to the sickness and evil that plagues the world. The readings invite us to ask Jesus to touch those places in us that need His healing, life-giving grace.

### REMINDER CONCERNING ASH WEDNESDAY

*From the Father Dave newsletter (from last week's bulletin)*

Last year Lent was already in progress when Covid-19 caused us to make some adjustments to liturgies. This year is different which means that ministers cannot apply ashes directly to congregant's foreheads in the regular way. But ashes will still be distributed in the following manner:

- At the time of the imposition of ashes, the celebrant addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general: "Repent and believe in the Gospel" or "Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return."
- The priest and ministers then cleanse their hands, put on face masks, and sprinkle the ashes on the top of the congregant's heads without saying anything. This last point would not involve touching anyone anywhere. According to the Catholic News Service, "Sprinkling ashes on the top of congregant's heads, rather than marking foreheads with ashes, is the customary practice at the Vatican and in Italy (see <http://www.catholicnews.com/for-ash-wednesday-vatican-asks-priests-to-sprinkle-ashes-on-heads/>)."
