Clergy Column

October, in addition to being the month of the Rosary, is also the time of year when we have 40 Days for Life, to pray for an end to Abortion. Each parish or parish cluster in our diocese has been assigned one of the forty days on which we are supposed to hold a Rosary-based event to pray for this important intention. The day our three parishes have been assigned is Tuesday, October 15th. Parishioners from all three of our parishes are asked to have this event together, so I think it will be best to have it St. Ann's in Goodridge at 7:00 p.m. I hope a potluck supper can be organized for 6:00 p.m., and at 7:00 we will have Adoration, pray the Rosary together, and then Benediction around 7:30. Please make plans to attend this event no matter which parish you live in! Please let me know if you'd be willing to organize the supper or help in any other way.

As I mentioned a few weeks ago, in the parishes of Oklee and Grygla, we're going to have an All-Parishioner meeting, for anyone to come to. We won't discuss finances; we won't discuss maintenance or remodel projects; we won't discuss anything controversial. The purpose of this meeting is to talk about what we want from our parishes... what you want your parishes to be, and what you are willing to do to make it happen. It's not meeting to drum up work for the priest to do, but a meeting to talk about what we want to do together. Sometimes we get too stuck in our lethargic ways, and it is time to rouse ourselves out of bed a bit. We'll begin each meeting with a Rosary. The meeting dates are as follows:

Prayer for the Church Authorities

(Composed by Archbishop Carroll in 1800.)

We pray Thee, O Almighty and Eternal God, who through Jesus Christ hast revealed Thy glory to all nations, to preserve the works of Thy mercy; that Thy Church, being spread through the whole world, may continue, with unchanging faith, in the confession of Thy name.

We pray Thee, who alone art good and holy, to endow with heavenly knowledge, sincere zeal, and sanctity of life our chief bishop, Pope Francis, the Vicar of our Lord Jesus Christ in the government of His Church; our own Bishop, Michael; all other Bishops, Prelates, and Pastors of the Church; and especially those who are appointed to exercise among us the functions of the holy ministry, and conduct Thy people into the ways of salvation.

We pray Thee, O God of might, wisdom, and justice, through whom authority is rightly administered, laws are enacted, and judgments decreed, assist, with Thy Holy Spirit of counsel and fortitude, the President of these United States, that his administration may be conducted in righteousness, and be eminently useful to Thy people, over whom he presides, by encouraging due respect for virtue and religion; by a faithful execution of the laws in justice and mercy; and by restraining vice and immorality. Let the light of Thy divine wisdom direct the deliberations of Congress, and shine forth in all the proceedings and laws framed for our role and government; so, that they may tend to the preservation of peace, the promotion of national happiness, the increase of industry, sobriety, and useful knowledge, and may perpetuate to us the blessings of equal liberty.

We pray for his Excellency the Governor of this State, for the members of the Legislature, for all Judges, Sheriffs, and other officers who are appointed to guard our political welfare; that they may be enabled, by Thy powerful protection, to discharge the duties of their respective stations with honesty and ability.

We recommend likewise to Thy unbounded mercy all our brethren and fellow-citizens, throughout the United States, that they may be blessed in the knowledge, and sanctified in the observance of most holy law; that they may be preserved in union, and in that peace which the world cannot give; and, after enjoying the blessings of this life, be admitted to those which are eternal.

Finally, we pray Thee, O Lord of mercy, to remember the souls of Thy servants departed who are gone before us with the sign of faith, and repose in the sleep of peace: the souls of our parents, relations, and friends; of those who, when living, were members of this congregation; and particularly of such as are lately deceased; of all benefactors who, by their donations or legacies to this Church, witnessed their zeal for the decency of divine worship, and proved their claim to our grateful and charitable remembrance. To these, O Lord, and to all that rest in Christ, grant, we beseech Thee, a place of refreshment, light, and everlasting peace, through the same Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.
