We want you to be **Life-Long Learners** ... **Future Leaders** ... **World Changers** ... because ...

#### YOU ARE AMAZING, INTELLIGENT, TALENTED, AND THE WORLD NEEDS YOU!

Last year we learned so much more than what was in the textbooks. This summer as you read and practice math, we challenge you to also continue practicing these other essential skills.
