

Maybe you have said, heard, or thought those words. Perhaps you have gone through life and wondered what it would be like to have a brother.

But you and I have a brother. And, "Jesus is not ashamed to call (us) brothers." Can you believe it? Think of how ashamed parents are when their child misbehaves in church. Think of how ashamed an upstanding member of a community is when his sister is arrested for dealing drugs. Think of how ashamed a child is when her father speaks rudely to the waitress at the

restaurant. Even we, sinful human beings, are ashamed of our relatives when they say and do things that are shameful.

In case of stormy weather, keep your radio tuned to WBEV (AM 1430), WXRO (FM 95.3), WTTN (AM 1580), WMDC (FM 98,7), WTMJ (AM 620), WISC (TV-



3), WTMJ (TV-4), WITI(TV-6), or WISN (TV-12) for the closing of school or early dismissal. Since many of our students ride the bus, normally our school closes when the local public school closes. Future freshmen course scheduling is scheduled at Lakeside Lutheran High School on Wednesday, January 16, at 7:00 P.M. and Saturday, January 19, at 9:00 A.M. The event is held in Lakeside's west gym. These sessions begin with a greeting and a brief presentation on signing up for freshmen courses. The financial aid process will also be explained. After this, every family—parents and student together—meets with a Lakeside teacher to develop a course schedule. There is no cost at this time to sign up for classes at Lakeside. Even if a family is uncertain on whether its student will enroll at Lakeside, it is encouraged to come to Lakeside for future freshmen course scheduling and create a tentative freshman schedule. If you are new to Lakeside, this would be a great opportunity to ask questions and find out more about what Lakeside has to offer. Most families will finish in 30-40 minutes.
