Parsonage Renovation Project

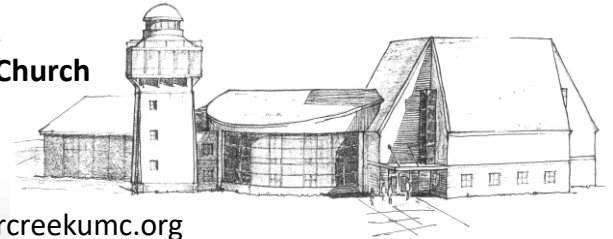
