VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: The backstop is almost completed. We are waiting on some parts that needed outside work and repair. When those are done, we will install the backstop. We are anticipating installation to occur in the first half of October. THE RANGE WILL BE CLOSED DURING BACKSTOP INSTALLATION UNTIL INSTALLATION IS COMPLETE. The more people we have helping install the backstop, the quicker the work will be completed and the less time the range will be closed. Installation will require the removal of part of the wall, so we will be going ahead and doing other upgrades such as adding bulletproof glass. We need people with carpentry knowledge, but all help is welcomed. We will have enough work for everyone to have a job. We will be working 7 days a week throughout the day until installation is complete. Please find a time to come out and help. Working on the backstop counts toward the \$25 maintenance discount on your renewal.

<u>PIT CLEANING INCENTIVES:</u> Clean the lead pit 7 times in the year and your

membership renewal for the following year will be FREE! Clean the lead pit 10 times in the year and be entered in a separate gun drawing for lead pit cleaning volunteers only. Lead pit cleaning is done immediately following the Saturday meeting.
