Bible sites come alive as we visit Mt. of Olives, Mt. Zion, and Bethlehem. We will focus on the ministry of Jesus as we visit the area of Galilee. We will also visit Amman; Ancient Philadelphia, Jerash, and Petra. This tour includes airfare, hotels with breakfast and dinners, comfortable A/C coach, transfers, exit and entrances taxes, group visa, 5 lunches, entrance fees, scholarly guides, and many extras at one price that individual travel does not match. Join us on this exciting tour to Israel and Jordan.

Itinerary - June 9-21, 2024



Day 1, Sunday, Travel from LAX.

Day 2, Monday, Arrive in Tel Aviv. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 3, Tuesday, Enjoy the day by visiting the Israeli Museum with Model of Jerusalem and the Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed. After lunch, visit Mt. Zion with the Church of St. Peter's in Gallicantu, where the rooster crowed, and see the stone pit where Jesus was held (Caiaphas' Palace). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 4, Wednesday, Begin the day by driving south along the Dead Sea to visit the fortress of Masada, taking a cable car to the top. This site is one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites. After lunch, you will have the opportunity to float in the Dead Sea. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 5, Thursday, You will visit the Temple Mount-Dome of the Rock and the Western Wall-Wailing Wall. You will then travel to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field. You will also enjoy a lunch at the Grotto and have time for shopping. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 6, Friday, Mount of Olives; from viewpoint, and continue to Pater Noster Church, commemorating the Lord's Prayer, Dominus Flevit Church, where Jesus wept over the city of Jerusalem, and the Garden of Gethsemane. After lunch, walk the Way of the Cross-Via Dolorosa, through the Old City streets, ending in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7, Saturday, Check out of the hotel. You will then drive north through the Jordan Valley, stopping at Beit She'an, where King Saul's head was hung on the city gate. This city was also known as Scythopolis during the Greek era. Overnight in Tiberias.

Day 8, Sunday, Sea of Galilee, including Mt. of Beatitudes, Tabgha, the place of Jesus' miracle of the Multiplication of the Fish and Loaves, Primacy of Peter, Capernaum: known as "Jesus' hometown." You will take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. You will also have a St. Peter's fish lunch. Overnight in Tiberias.

Day 9, Monday, Check out of the hotel. Drive to Sheikh Hussein-Jordan River border crossing to enter Jordan. After arriving in Jordan, you will visit ancient Jerash, which is considered the most well-preserved Roman ruins that remain outside of Italy. You will spend the night in Amman.

Day 10, Tuesday, Begin the day with the Amman city tour, including the Amman Citadel and Roman theater, which are both impressive ruins of Roman Philadelphia. After lunch, drive south through Jordan, arriving in Petra for overnight.

Day 11, Wednesday, Full day at Petra: Tour with the guide to see the Siq, Treasury, Theatre, and Street of Facades. There will be ample free time for you to visit the Royal Tombs, High Place of Sacrifice, Monastery, and the ancient Byzantine Church remains, if you should choose. Overnight in Petra.

Day 12, Thursday, Check out of the hotel and drive north to Allenby Bridge border crossing. Once in Israel, travel toward Tel Aviv for a farewell dinner and overnight. Overnight in Tel Aviv or possible night flight back to the U.S., with arrival the following day.

Day 13, Friday, If the group is spending the night in Tel Aviv on Day 12, you will depart this morning on your flight back to the U.S. Arrive back to the U.S.
