President Tesdall is requesting a chairperson for the Pat Reid Baby contest. Please contact her if you are interested.

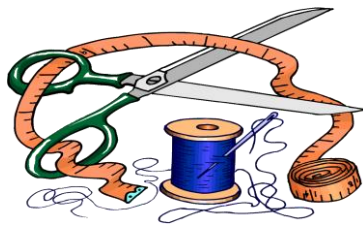
