# RESOLUTION 71-11 TOWN BOARD APPROVED THE 11/09/11 & 11/30/11 MINUTES

Motion Rarilee Conway; Seconded Darin Forbes; All in Favor

#### Randy gave an update on Town Projects:

- \*The pavilion is complete.
- \*The Town applied for and was denied a grant that would finish the beach project.
- \*The paving will still need to be done; FEMA funds may possibly be used for the paving.
- \*FEMA funds have been received for the spring flood.
- \*FEMA paperwork has been submitted for Hurricane Irene. Funds are not expected to be received until possibly August of 2012.
- \*The estimate to do the dam and the flashboards is approximately \$50,000.
- \*A grant was approved in the amount of \$48,900 to purchase the T-ball field. The total cost will be \$60,000.

#### Update on water district transformer issue.

- \*A refurbished transformer has been ordered for approximately \$30,000. Should receive it in 4-6 weeks.
- \*The system is running on a generator at this time.

\*Randy Preston noted that he was very impressed with NMIR and the ease of the claim for this emergency situation.

There is a \$1,000 deductible for this claim.
