AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1-3-16 OF DIVISION II – CITY CLERK OF THE NEWTON CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF NEWTON, JASPER COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Newton, Illinois, that Section 1-3-16 of Division II – City Clerk of the Newton City Code is hereby amended in its entirety to provide as follows:

DIVISION II – CITY CLERK

1-3-16 <u>ELECTED.</u> The Clerk shall be elected at the same election as the Mayor for a **four (4) year term** and shall serve until a successor is elected and has qualified. Effective May 1, 2025 the City Clerk's position shall be a full-time elected position for which the City Clerk shall receive Fifty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$58,000.00) per year. For said salary the City Clerk shall work Forty (40) hours per week in the City Clerk's office and shall attend the bi-monthly City Council meetings. The City Clerk shall also perform such other duties as the City may request from time to time.

Except as amended hereby, the City Code of Newton, Illinois, shall remain in full force and effect according to its original terms and provisions, as Amended, from time to time.
