RIDING IN THE COLD

Depending on where you live in Florida and what type of "Cold Front" you are experiencing that day will determine whether or not you are going to ride. If you are going to ride, here are a few things to consider for your safety. Let's first look at the physical effects to your body when it is cold. Your reaction movements are slowed down due to your muscles and joints being colder and your finger movement being restricted due to possibly arthritis or just by thicker gloves. If your body temperature gets too cold this can also slow your thinking process, which will slow down your reaction time.

What can we do to keep warm? The obvious answer is to dress appropriately to cut down on the "Wind Chill Factor". "Wind Chill Factor" is the cold wind passing by your body and lowering your body temperature with air temperature lower than the actual outside air temperature. I have included a "Wind Chill Factor Chart" to this article. As you look at the Chart, you will

see on the Left Side the "Speed of the Wind". When you are riding a motorcycle, "You" are the "Speed of the Wind" added to any existing "Head Wind Speed". For illustration purposes let's look at the Left Side of the Chart at a Wind Speed of 55mph. That represents you traveling at 55mph creating your own Wind Speed. Now, let's look at the Top of the Chart at go down to 45 degrees. (A temperature that could easily be happening on a cold Florida morning.) The Chart shows that the "Wind Chill" temperature would be 32 degrees. 32 degrees is a freezing temperature on you, although the actual outside temperature is only 45 degrees.

Dressing appropriately means knowing what to wear and what works. "Thermal Underwear" is a big help. "Electric Underwear" is even better. Electric Underwear plugs into you motorcycle and has a dial controlled thermostat to regulate the temperature like a heating blanket. Electric Underwear pieces include: socks,

pant liner, jacket liner and gloves. You must wear appropriate outerwear to block cold air from penetrating through your cloths to keep the warmth in.

The design of your motorcycle can also serve to help keep the cold wind off of you. A windshield, upper and lower fairing, and wind deflectors can help keep you warm. If you do not have a lower fairing, "Chaps" can help keep the cold wind directly off of your legs. A rain suit can also be utilized to cut down on the cold wind passing through your motorcycle clothing. A thin rain jacket can be worn under your motorcycle jacket and rain pants can be worn over your motorcycle pants to cut down on the cold air passing through your clothing.

The cold weather is here. Prepare to properly deal with it to keep yourself warm and alert.

We are here to assist you with anything you need for you to maintain being a safe rider.

These presentations are designed to be delivered to EWMA members (only) by any current EWMA member with an interest in a particular topic or topics. Technically, there are no "instructors" for the off-bike presentations, only current members willing to deliver a safety presentation or pre-ride safety briefing.

I can assist volunteers' preparation as needed. Final selections are subject to negotiation. Here are the 10 possible presentation titles for your quick review. These topics are sized for about 30 minutes and are considered ideal for a rally or ride-in event.

3. First Responder Actions at an Accident Scene
4. Riding in the Mountains
5. Riding at Night

If you have read any of my articles this past year, then you know that I find some of the most interesting information from outside magazines and post that I have received and read. So I hope you enjoy this month's article too. I wonder how many of you find yourself in this situation. Could this be one of your resolutions this new year?

Want to Kick Phone Addition? By Lexi Pandell

Believe it or not, there's an app for that.

Your phone dings with a notification. After checking, do you find yourself scrolling through social media or playing a game?

There's a reason for such Pavlovian reactions and habitual use. "App makers have gotten clever at not only keeping you interested, but keeping your eyeballs there and wanting to be there," says Larry Rosen, a psychology professor and coauthor of *The Distracted Mind: Ancient Brains in a High-Tech World*. Once notifications activate our curiosity, smart phones are designed to

ensnare us with messages from friends, news stories and entertainment. "It's difficult for your brain to shake that," Rosen says.

Enter focus apps. These discourage you from using your phone. Some have productivity timers, which are designed to keep your eyes off your phone with virtual rewards. When you open *Forest* (\$4.00), you grow a tree in the app. When you close out to use other apps, the tree withers. With *Focus Dog* (free), the longer you stick with your timed focus session, the more points you get, represented by doughnuts fed to a cute dog.

Other apps use a stick instead of a carrot. *DTCH* (\$10/month) makes your phone vibrate when you unlock it and sometimes won't stop until you've put it down. And *Offscreen* (\$4.50/year) shocks you with numbers, tracking hours of phone usage and how often you unlock it.

But Rosen says that the apps can get frustrating and suggests a different tactic: Retrain your brain to focus. Start with 15 minutes away from your phone. Work up from there until you can be away from your phone for longer stretches.

How many of you are on your phone way too much? Maybe one of your resolutions this year should be putting down your phone more.

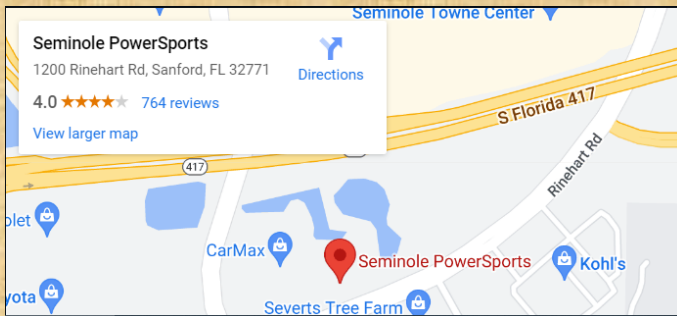
