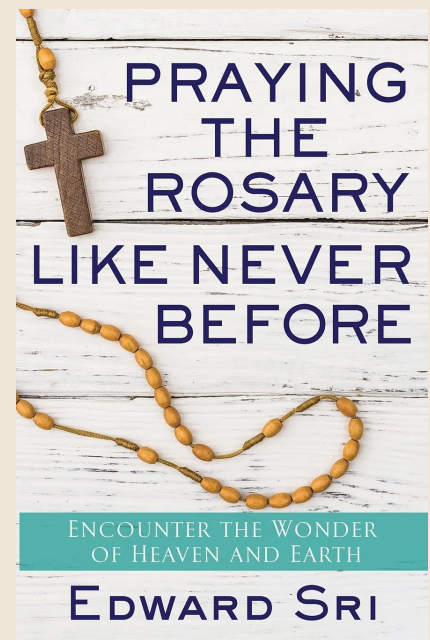
Praying the Rosary Like Never Before
