

Double Trouble

Guess the words defined by clues such that you can complete the grid. The words that are entered in the grid vary in length from three to eleven letters long and of these, four are capitalized and one is an abbreviation. As always, punctuation in the clues may or may not help the solver.

Enter the answers in the grid one after the other starting in the top left corner and in the same order as the clues. Across words that don't end at the rightmost square of the row will continue on leftmost square of the next row. Similarly, down words that do not end in the bottom square will continue at the top of the next column.

Five across words and five down words need to be changed to a different word first as per the process defined by the unclued Mystery Entry.
