

Peaceful Pieces

Create a quilt that gives you a feeling of peace. It can be based on a quilt that brings back warm memories, a color palette that relaxes you, a literal depiction of a location or event where you feel most at peace or even an iconic peace sign.

The challenging part? You must purchase a fat quarter of the *2018 challenge fabric*, which will be available at the Quilt Show table for \$2.00. You must include at least **three pieces** of this fabric in **three different shapes**. Such as a square, triangle, rectangle, half square triangle or circle. Three-dimensional elements such as yo-yos or prairie points are fine. Appliqued elements count if they are different shapes. Binding, labels and backing do not count.

For those who want to start planning before they see the challenge quilt fabric - it is a small red pattern on a yellow background.



Rules: Must be exactly 20" x 20" (note the change from prior years). It must meet the generally accepted definition of a quilt - a sandwich consisting of two layers of fabric, with batting in between; either quilted or tied.
