English

We will begin this term by looking at quest stories, Adventures At Sandy Cove and Ice Palace, using our Talk 4 Writing to develop our vocabulary, grammar, spelling and story telling skills. We will be particularly focusing on using a thesaurus to develop our language.

Next, we will be looking at nonchronological reports and the features of these whilst learning facts about the Titanic. We will write newspaper reports and nonfiction texts using facts we learn.



Mathematics

This term we will further consolidate our understand of the four operations; add, subtract, multiply and divide. We will build on our place value knowledge to help with this.

During the term, we will be learning how to tell the time using analogue and digital clocks.

We will be learning about fractions and using practical methods to deepen our understanding of these.

History/Geography

We will learn all about the famous Titanic, her maiden voyage and how it affected people living in the early 1900s.

Music

In Year 3, we will continue to learn to play the ukulele. We will also investigate composition with Mr McDermott.

ICT

We will be improving our maths with Mathletics and learning to code using Purple Mash.

Science

Our Science this term will look at forces and magnets, linking our learning to Titanic and how ships float. We will be carrying out a range of investigations to explore how forces work and how friction can impact upon cars.

French

In our French lessons we will be learning about how to introduce ourselves to others and how to talk about the weather.
