Monday, 2/11 1 Kings 8:22-30

What can you learn about prayer from this passage? How can you share with God your true feelings in prayer?

Tuesday, 2/12 1 Kings 12:27-33

Although we may not publicly erect "golden calves," there may be things that overshadow our worship and reverence of God. What may be those things in your life that demand your attention rather than God...reputation, power, money, status, family, leisure, hobbies...?

Wednesday, 2/13 1 Kings 17:7-16

What would it be like if you trusted God this much? Is it possible that your life could be radically and fundamentally transformed if you trusted God just a little more each and every day, as the widow did? Consider this - Trusting God is a process.

Thursday, 2/14 1 Kings 21:20-29

How does Ahab's sin make you feel? How do you feel when Ahab repents? How does God's response to this repentance make you feel?

Friday, 2/15 2 Kings 4:20-29

Are there any desires deep within that you are afraid to trust God with? What holds you back? How can you trust God more fully?

Saturday, 2/16 2 Kings 11:17-12:2

What do you most like or dislike about Jehoiada? Who do you look to as a teacher or leader? What qualities or characteristics do you admire in them?
