## MASS READING REFLECTION

### May 20, 2018

1st Reading Is Acts 2:1-11 [Coming of the Spirit]

The Bible, especially the New Testament, should never be read in the past tense. It is God's word to you and me now! Jesus is alive. His Spirit is with every Christians. This is the meaning of the Christ event. meaningfully celebrated at Easter , Ascension, and Pentecost, three aspects of the one mystery.

Luke follows the early Christians custom of celebrating the communication of the Spirit at the conclusion of the "great fifty days," our Pentecost. Hence, he relates the outpouring of the Spirit as we have it in the First Reading. John puts the communication of the Spirit on Easter day (Gospel). The gift of the Spirit is one with the risen Lord Jesus. (See Theme for the 7th Sunday of Easter—A, p.475.) Notice that both traditions stress that the Christian message is not just for the Jews but for all people.


#### 2nd Reading1 Cor 12:3b-7,12-13 [Grace of the Spirit]

Paul is concerned about his congregation in Corinth. In it, a charismatic group has originated and glossolalia (speaking in tongues) is practiced its effect on the congregation has not been good. Those who have failed to participate are looked upon as second-class Christians and divisiveness has ensued. Paul does not condemn the movement.

He sees in it the Spirit at work. But on the other hand he stresses that the outpouring of the spirit must build up the community (the body of Christ), not tear it apart.

To have the spirit means, first of all, to confess: "Jesus is Lord." This is done in various ways, not just by speaking in tongues. Each gift, even the least spectacular one, must be used for the common good ! This could be a reminder to contemporary movement and countermovements in the church.




