700 MHz INTERIM STATUS PERFORMANCE REPORT

Licensee hereby submits this Interim Performance Status Report pursuant to Section 27.14(l) of the Commission's rules.

1. Licensee acquired the License on March 7, 2014 pursuant to the Agreement and Plan of Merger among Leap Wireless International, Inc. ("Leap"), AT&T Inc., Laser, Inc. ("Laser"), and Mariner Acquisition Sub Inc. (the "Merger Agreement"). The Merger Agreement contemplated that the License would be sold at the direction of Laser, with the net proceeds of the sale to be distributed to the former Leap shareholders through a contingent value right arrangement. In the interim, Laser would have *de facto* control over the License and would have responsibility for maintaining the License, including entering into a consensual arrangement to address the technical issues related to the digital television protection criteria applicable to the broadcast station signal adjacent to the License.
2. Since Licensee's acquisition of the License, an affiliate of Licensee and Laser have each conducted testing to determine the effects of operating a wireless network on the 700 MHz A Block in the Market adjacent to concurrent over-the-air TV broadcasting by WPWR-TV.
3. Laser has negotiated an agreement with the licensee for WPWR-TV, Fox Television Stations, LLC ("FTS"), which, upon the fulfillment of several conditions, will permit the operation of the License within the exclusion zone surrounding the FTS broadcasting antenna in the Market.
4. On May 20, 2016, an agreement was executed to assign the License to T-Mobile License LLC.
5. Licensee does not currently provide services within the Market over the frequencies covered by the License.
