A MESSAGE FROM WALK #161 SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

As I write this note my heart is saddened. I just heard the news about our friend Rev. Glen Pugh. I was just with him on Monday at the Bishop's Day Apart. Our conversation was short, but he still touched my heart. It wasn't too many years ago that I worked a walk with Glen, he was the Spiritual Director and I was an ALD. During Dying Moments I was standing, directing pilgrims from their seats so that they could visit with Glen. I had a clear vision of Glen, and the sight brought tears to my eyes, then and even as I write this note. 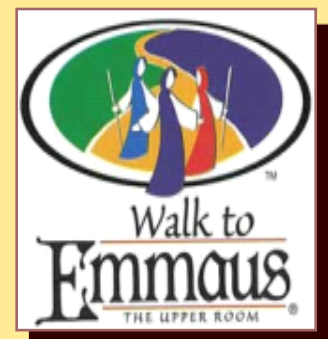

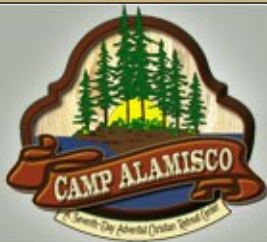

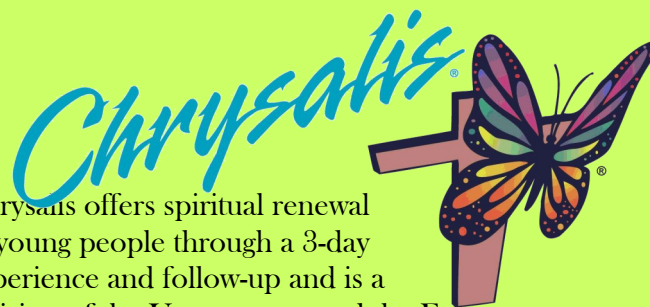
