- 1. **Solubility** Solubility describes how easily a material (solute) will dissolve in water.
- 2. **Solute** the substance that dissolves in a solvent. (Example: tea)
- 3. **Solvent** the liquid the solute dissolves in (mainly water).
- 4. **Solution** a transparent liquid that is a result of a solute dissolving into a solvent. (Example: iced tea)
- 5. <u>Unsaturated Solution</u> more solute can be dissolved into a solvent.
- 6. Saturated Solution no more solute can be dissolved into a solvent.
- 7. **Supersaturated Solution** an unstable solution where crystals form.
- 8. <u>Electrical Conductivity</u> Conductors that allow electricity to flow through them. (Example: wires)
- 9. Reflectivity How much light reflects off of the surface of substances. (metal, glass, rocks)
- 10. <u>Properties</u> Properties are words that describe the characteristics of matter. (Examples: color, shape, texture)
- 11. <u>Matter</u> Matter is what makes up all objects in the world. Matter is anything that has mass and volume.
- 12. <u>Physical Change</u> A physical change is a change in size, shape, or state of matter that does NOT create a new substance. (Example: Tearing paper)
- 13. <u>Chemical Change</u> A chemical change is a change that occurs to matter and a new substance is created. (Example: Burning paper)
- 14. <u>Atom</u> All matter is made out of small particles called atoms, which are too small to see.
