

Sahuaro Fastpitch Bullying Policy

Bullying is not tolerated within our league. The goal of Sahuaro Fastpitch is to build our players up as both people and players. We expect that our players will treat their teammates and opposing team players with respect.

Sahuaro Players who feel they are being bullied or see someone else being bullied should let their coach know right away.

Sahuaro Coaches should be proactively talking with their teams about bullying and set an example with leadership on and off the field. This includes interaction with players, coaches on their team, coaches on opposing teams and umpires. When a player reports bullying the coach should reach out to the parents as well as inform league board members.

Sahuaro Parents, please do not take matters into your own hands. Confronting the person believed to be bullying is not okay. Parents are encouraged to sit down together and help come to a resolution, not to point fingers.

Sahuaro Board If a resolution cannot be met, it is the board's duty to monitor and implement repercussions for all parties involved, up to and including suspension of games or removal from the league.
