The Airdrie LAV III, the first [LAV III Monument](#) in Western Canada, provides the citizens of Airdrie with important recognition of the dedicated service as well as the many and significant sacrifices made by members of the Canadian Armed Forces in Afghanistan and elsewhere. The installation of this monument serves as a public thank you from a grateful nation.

The Airdrie LAV III monument not only commemorates the fallen in Afghanistan, who have made the ultimate sacrifice for their country, it recognizes all the men and women whose lives have been forever changed by their notable contributions, both to their country, and to the many places in our world where they had been deployed as part of their service.

This monument affords the opportunity for a full recognition of the contributions and events of our past as we collectively work to empower our youth on their journey towards becoming our leaders of tomorrow.

The monument is located at the Nose Creek Valley Museum in Airdrie, AB and it's the first such monument for Albertans and will ultimately be one of many located across Canada.
