In today's Gospel, as Jesus and his disciples are crossing to the other side of the Sea of Galilee away from the crowds, a violent windstorm arises causing the waves to "beat into the boat". While Jesus sleeps peacefully, the disciples panic, afraid that they are about to sink. We too can be buffeted by great storms in life — illness, job loss, betrayal, stress, to name a few — and, like the disciples,



we too can have a tendency to panic. Such storms, as difficult as they are, may indeed be a test of love so that our faith, "which is more precious than gold", may be refined and deepen. In today's Gospel, Jesus is guiding the disciples – and us – toward full and complete trust in him. When we experience difficult times, we need to remind ourselves that Jesus is experiencing them alongside us, loving us and saving us from being overwhelmed by them. At such times, let us hear the words spoken by Jesus in today's Gospel, "Peace! Be still!" and let us draw on our faith which can help us recognize Jesus' presence in our lives, both in times of calmness and in times of adversity.

JUNE 24 - SOLEMNITY OF THE NATIVITY OF SAINT JOHN THE **BAPTIST:** This feast is celebrated on this day as it is six months before the birth of Christ. With its proximity to the summer solstice, it

signifies the waning of the light, while the birth of Jesus near the winter solstice marks the coming of the light. John was given his name on the occasion of his birth in accordance with an angel's instruction to his father, Zechariah. In disbelief that he and Elizabeth would have a son. Zechariah asked for a sign and was struck dumb.

but in the giving of the name, his speech was restored.

JUNE 28 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT IRENAEUS, BISHOP, MARTYR: Irenaeus was ordained a priest and later became a bishop. His writings in refuting heresies helped lay the foundations of Christian theology. Perhaps his most important contribution was his assertion that creation is not sinful by nature, but rather distorted by sin. As God created us, so God redeemed us: our fallen human nature could only be saved by Christ assuming it in the Incarnation.



JUNE 29 - SOLEMNITY OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES: Peter was first known as Simon, but after he confessed that Jesus was "the Christ, the Son of the living God" Jesus changed his name to Peter and told him that it was on this rock that he would build his Church. From the middle of the third century, documents show that the Bishops of Rome were recognized as the successors of Peter. Paul was at first a zealous persecutor of Christians, but he underwent a profound conversion and became an ardent follower of Christ, spending his remaining years bearing witness to Christ and teaching and preaching the Good News. Both Peter and Paul were martyred in Rome.
