

Fleming, Mildred

Mildred J. Fleming, longtime Pinnebog resident, died Friday afternoon, October 31, 2003, at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon. She was born in Port Hope at the home of her parents, the late William and Sarah (Cowie) Varney, in the early 1900s. After high school and a year of college she returned to the area. On August 27, 1928, she was united in marriage to Charles J. Fleming in Bowling Green, Ohio. They made their home at the south limits of Pinnebog where they farmed all their married life. Charlie preceded her in death on July 14, 1970. Mildred was a life-long member of the Chandler Presbyterian Church, life member of the Order of Eastern Star, past member of the Pinnebog Women's Club and Pinnebog Bridge Club. She enjoyed playing cards, working around the house and yard, and taking care of her family. Surviving are her daughter, Judy Lesock, of Caseville; nine grandchildren, Jane, Patty, Bill, Judy, Tracey, Dan, Todd, Stephanie and Jim; 16 great-grandchildren, Tara, Rochelle, Stephanie, L.J., Charlie, Jim, Jaime, Chancey, Joey, Angel, Ryan, Alex, Patrick, Liam, Lauren and Quinn; and six great-great grandchildren, Brody, Kylie, Drew, Lindsey, Skye and Ryan.
