

Level 3: Knitting: Gothic Lace Cowl or Scarf

Gothic Lace features a simple, symmetrical, and repetitive lace pattern worked in worsted or aran weight yarn. Following this pattern you can make a short cowl, a longer cowl or a scarf by spending a bit more time! The pattern includes both a lace chart and line-by-line text instructions, so that you can compare the two, and become comfortable knitting from a chart. Courtesy of Tin Can Knits.

Objectives:

To further build on your knitting skills by learning how to:

- Read a lace chart
- Make a button loop (knit or crochet)
- Wet block your piece and see how the finished size will vary depending on yarn used and how aggressively you block your piece.

- Stitch markers, darning needle, 8 buttons *

*I will have some buttons for your creations.
