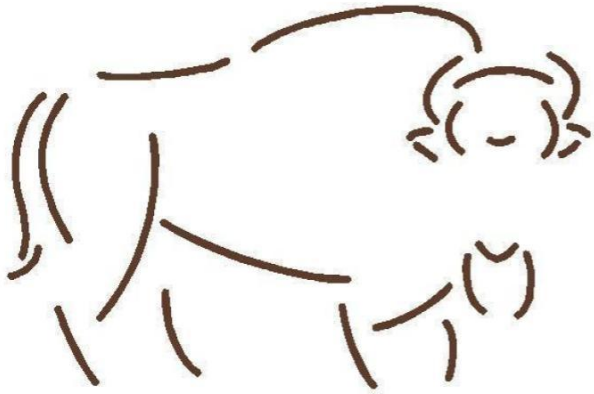
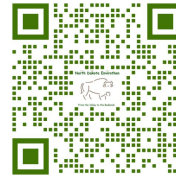


North Dakota Envirothon

The North Dakota Envirothon is a hands-on, problem-solving natural resource competition for high school students. Teams of 5 compete in the areas of soils, aquatics, wildlife, forestry, and prairie. These 1-day events cost only \$25/team. We encourage all teams/schools to try out an events to see what an Envirothon competition is all about. Each competition is mostly outdoors and includes team testing and education stations hosted by natural resource professionals.
