Summersville Lake Reopening Plan

Following are the highlights of the Summersville Lake Reopening Plan:

According to the Governor of West Virginia's campground operating guidelines, only West Virginia residents will be permitted to enter campgrounds until further notice. If you currently have a camping reservation and are not a West Virginia resident, please cancel your reservations on www.recreation.gov through June 9, 2020. All reservation fees for cancelled days will be automatically refunded.

Day Use Fees - day use fees are waved until October 1, 2020. This includes boat launch and beach fees. Camping fees still apply.

Battle Run Campground – opens 7:30 AM on May 20, 2020 to in-state residents.

Register and check in at the entrance booth. Visitors to campsites will be limited. No more than 10 persons will be permitted on a campsite at any time. A maximum of 8 overnight campers is permitted. The washhouses will be open, and playgrounds will remain closed.

Battle Run Launch Ramps – is currently open. Launch fees are not being charged. The restroom is open.

Battle Run Beach – will open May 21, 2020. Restroom will be open. Beach traffic will be restricted to 50% of peak capacity & a specific number of parking spaces will be designated for beach customers. The beach will close to new customers each day when the designated parking spaces become full.

Long Point (Marina) Launch Ramps – is currently open. Launch fees are not being charged. The restroom is open.

Salmon Run Area – is open, including restroom. Day use fees are not being charged.

Damsite Picnic Area – Shelters are open to groups of 25 or less. The restroom is open and the playground is closed.

All visitors are asked to follow these steps to recreate responsibly: honor the 6' social distancing rule, wear masks when required, practice good disinfecting procedures, stay home if you are sick or have symptoms, keep parks clean by practicing "pack in and pack out" etiquette, and always wear a life jacket when near the water.

Also, if a Corps employee, volunteer, or contractor is working on your campsite or in your presence, **PLEASE** maintain social distancing.
