


- (b) Responses to the motions to compel arbitration shall be filed by January 25, 2012
 - (c) Replies in support of motions to compel arbitration shall be filed by January 27, 2012
 - (d) *all objections to motion to mediate or entering of scheduling order to be filed by January 30, 2012.*
3. On February 14, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. (3 hours), hearing:
- (a) State's motion for summary judgment on securities fraud issues
 - (b) Retirement Value Receiver's motion for summary judgment on fraudulent transfer and breach of fiduciary duty
 - (c) Retirement Value Receiver's Ninth Application for Fees
4. On March 28, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. (2 hours), a hearing is set on the Retirement Value Receiver's motions for summary judgment against licensees arguing that the licensees engaged in the unlawful sale of unregistered securities.
- (a) Motions for summary judgment shall be filed by January 24, 2012
 - (b) Responses to the motions for summary judgment shall be filed by February 24, 2012
 - (c) Any replies in support of the motions for summary judgment shall be filed by March 2, 2012.
5. On April 9, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. (3 hours), a hearing is set regarding approving a plan of distribution for Retirement Value.
- (a) The Retirement Value Receiver shall file a plan of distribution by January 3, 2012.
 - (b) Alternate plan(s) of distribution shall be filed by January 17, 2012.
 - (c) Objections to plan(s) of distribution shall be filed by February 21, 2012.
6. On January 7, 2013, trial will be held on the claims asserted by the State and the Receivers. The court has reserved three weeks for trial. The parties are instructed to work together to create a Level III Discovery Control Order pursuant to Rule 190.4. The scheduling order is due on January 20, 2012.
