On the agenda is the nominations of officers, old business where we begin to actively organize the Mike Robinson tournament with Marty handling the event and the voting on the motions brought up at the last meeting. All motions below were seconded. As required, the motions are as follows:

Motion #1: On a regular club 2-day tournament, drawing will be made for the first of the 2-day and the numbers will be reversed for the second day. No second drawing.

Motion #2: Membership will require attending a meeting, register at the meeting and proof of insurance presented.

Motion #3: Penalty of presenting a dead fish be changed from .5 pound to .25 pound. (FWC requires at least .25 pound penalty for tournaments)

Motion #4: Classic tournament non-boaters selected in descending order based on points

Motion #5: Classic qualifiers with boats be allowed to use their own boat regardless of position in the top 16.

Motion #6: Members unable to attend meeting due to cause such as sickness or employment allow to attend via cell phone and get ½ the points (2-3?).

Motion #7: Big motor running, no lines in the water.

Motion #8: December counted one of five qualifiers to fish mini-bucks final.

Will take a hand count of those who will/will not fish if tournament held on East Toho. Some expressed concern.
