Rev. Terry Ivy came to Christ in 1980 at the age of 18 out of a non-religious family and from a life-style of worldliness and sin. He entered full-time Christian ministry in 1984 at the age of 22 and has ministered to various gatherings over the past 32 years.

Terry is founder of PROJECT INDIA, a church planting ministry in unreached areas of India. He has overseen the training of 22 missionaries and the planting of 162 churches over the past 4 years, with over 30,000 Hindus and Muslims surrendering to Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.

Also, along with his wife, Susanne, they have an orphanage which cares for 16 children that lost their parents in a flood in 2011. He has a strong passion to reach men with the gospel and to equip all believers, young and old, to proclaim with boldness the truths of God's Word to a lost and dying world.

Rev. Roger Parsons - Evangelist | June 25-26



Rev. Roger Parsons accepted the call to ministry in 1962 at 15 years of age and began speaking at camps, revivals and retreats which he has continued through the present. He has pastored churches in Ohio, Indiana, Michigan and North Carolina. Roger current pastors Old Zion Wesleyan Church in Tabor City, North Carolina.

Roger served The Wesleyan Church as General Evangelist from 1997-2003, in various district roles and was a contributing author to Light from the Word, a Wesleyan published devotional. He also served on the mission field in Puerto Rico (1982) and Liberia and Sierra Leona (2009).

Roger and his wife, Sue, have been married since 1968. They have three adult children, two living in Ohio and one in North Carolina, and four grandchildren.

DIRECTIONS

From Concord - Take the Kannapolis Parkway to Mooresville Road (Hwy. 3). Turn right and go down to Charlie Walker Road and turn left. Charlie Walker Road become Enochville Avenue. Turn left on Wright Road. Go to the end of Wright Road and turn left. Immediately turn left again on Deal Road. Camp Wesley is about a mile ahead on the right.

From Kannapolis - Go to the end of West "C" Street and turn left on Enochville Avenue. Turn right on Wright Road. Go to the end of Wright Road and turn left. Immediately turn left again on Deal Road. Camp Wesley is about a mile ahead on the right.

From China Grove - Take Hwy. 152 West and turn left on Deal Road at the Atwell Fire Station. Camp Wesley is 3.2 miles on the right.

From Landis - Take Hwy. 153 to Hwy 152 West and turn left on Deal Road at the Atwell Fire Station. Camp Wesley is 3.2 miles on the right.

From I-77 - Take Exit 36 to Hwy. 50 East. Go 6.3 miles and take Hwy. 152 East toward China Grove. Go 3.7 miles and turn right on Unity Church Road. Go to the stop sign and turn left on Deal Road. Camp Wesley is just ahead on the left.

Camp History

Camp Wesley's history spans 80 years. As early as 1936, a small group of Christians organized by Mr. M. C. Scercy erected the first arbor on the property of G.L. Rogers in rural Rowan County, North Carolina.

In 1946, M. C. Scercy's nephew, Rev. William Scercy, felt led of the Lord to organize a camp meeting board. Several selected men with interest in beginning a camp meeting gathered at the home of Mr. Ray Daniels of Kannapolis, NC on September 6, 1946. The motion carried to name the camp, "Camp Wesley Interdenominational Holiness Camp."

The first camp meeting was held August 1-10, 1947. The group soon purchased a five-acre plot of land from Mr. G. L. Rogers, still the current site of Camp Wesley. The first permanent buildings on the grounds were a 60' by 80' open-air tabernacle and a small dining hall. Today, eight buildings cover the Camp Wesley grounds with a new fellowship center completed in 2006.

With an eye toward the future, the Camp Wesley board purchased an additional five acres adjoining the property with plans for recreational areas, an additional dormitory and RV/camper space. To further aid in Camp Wesley's development, an additional tract measuring 140 by 150 feet adjacent to the camp was donated to Camp Wesley during the 1999 Camp Meeting.

Rev. William Scercy, W.H. Hall, Rev. Frank Ostwalt, Grover Beaver, and Rev. E.T. Houston have served as past presidents of the camp. Rev. Trent Patterson, currently Camp President, and the Camp Wesley directors look forward to many years of continued ministry in the community.
