

VILLAGE OF DRYDEN

GARBAGE COLLECTION ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 42

An ordinance to provide for garbage collection services within the Village; to specify the types of properties which shall qualify for garbage collection services; to require the taking of bids; to provide for garbage collection services by contract; to provide for the setting of fees for garbage collection services; to authorize the inclusion of garbage collection fees on the tax roll; to establish a garbage collection fund; and to provide for the collection of delinquent fees.

THE VILLAGE OF DRYDEN ORDAINS:

Section 1. AUTHORITY. The Village Council, pursuant to the authorizations contained in Act 3 of the Public Acts of 1895 and Act 320 of 1927, as amended, shall provide for garbage collection services for the residents of the Village in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 2. SERVICE. Garbage collection service shall be provided on equal terms to all dwelling units within the Village. Any multiple family dwelling which generates a large amount of garbage may be required to have a dumpster for garbage collection service.

Section 3. BIDS. The Village Council shall solicit bids from persons interested in providing garbage collection services for the Village.

Section 4. CONTRACT. If a satisfactory bid is received, the Village Council shall enter into a contract with the successful bidder.

Section 5. FEE. Upon execution of the garbage collection contract, the Village Council shall set a fee to be charged to each unit to be provided garbage collection services. Multiple family units for which dumpsters are required shall have a special fee to cover dumpster collection costs.

Section 6. ASSESSMENT. The Village Assessor shall assess the garbage collection fee in the amount determined by the Village Council against all parcels of property within the Village which may utilize garbage collection services. Each parcel of property shall be assessed a fee for each dwelling unit or other unit located on the parcel which may utilize the garbage collection service.

Section 7. FUND. A garbage collection fund shall be established into which all fees shall be deposited and from which all contract payments shall be made. Any money collected in excess of the contract payments shall be retained in the fund and shall be used to defray the cost of future garbage collection services.

Section 8. DELINQUENT FEES. All fees assessed shall constitute a lien on the property assessed and shall constitute a debt of the owner of the property. In case of delinquency, the fee may be collected as delinquent village property taxes or by a suit against the owner.

Section 9. SEVERABILITY. This Ordinance and the various sections, sentences and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be unconstitutional and invalid.
