The fall is here and we are in full gear. September we're back at the Brigantine where we will be taking reservations and donations for the fashion show.



- We have until September 13 to make calls for the Recall Election.
- The phone numbers you will be calling will be on your i360 phone app
- Reform California is keeping track of who has already turned in their ballots using data from the ROV.
- Every person you are connected to on the phone has not yet mailed in their ballot or voted in person.
- That is why these calls are important. They are not a waste of time...you are actually contacting or leaving a message with voters that haven't voted yet.
- We can win this, but we need super turn-out.
- Everyone can help, even your friends or family members...just sign up with <u>YesonRecall.org</u> and then download the app for i360. You will be contacted with a username and password.

Now begin...

Open the i360 app - Input your user name and password

(Trump2020)

Choose Reform California

Choose Recall Newsom Call Program

Choose **Automated Dialing**

Select **Speaker Phone** (at the top of the screen)

Click Take Call

Hear Music - see - Stand By at bottom of Screen

Voter phone answers – **see Voter's name** at bottom of screen.

Talk to the voter or leave message when asked. See script at end of this message.

Click **Voter's Name** when finished speaking. Click **Skip** then Click **Hang Up and Submit.**

Now you are back to Music and waiting for next call.

Very Short Message:

Say: Hello is this George Brown? or for message machine... Hello, This message is for George Brown

Say: My name is Sally and I'm with the Carl DeMaio Office.

I'm calling about the election to <u>recall Governor Newsom</u> and asking you to <u>Vote YES on the recall</u> question.

Say: On the second question, you pick who you want for the next governor.

Say: Please Mail your ballot back by Sept. 6.

Say: Don't forget you must sign and date on the outside of the envelope in the red box.

Say: Thank you very much, George, thanks for your time.

Click **Voter's Name** when finished Click **Skip** - Click **Hang Up and Submit.**

And you're done with this call!
