

Chapter 184. Vehicles and Traffic

§ 184-10. Temporary parking prohibition for snow plowing and removal.

A. Removal.

- (1) Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the streets or highways, an emergency shall exist and no vehicle shall be parked on any municipal or county street, road or highway, except alternate side parking during the emergency shall be permitted on Main Street and Academy Street, in accordance with the following schedule:

Name of Street	Sides	Location	Days
Main Street	North	Entire length	Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Sunday
Main Street	South	Entire length	Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday
Academy Street	East	Main Street to Park Place	Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Sunday
Academy Street	West	Main Street to Park Place	Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday

- (2) The above parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.

- B. Any unoccupied vehicle parked in violation of this section shall be deemed a nuisance inimical to the public health, safety and welfare and subject to ticketing or towing in the sound discretion of any police officer charged with enforcing this chapter. If a vehicle is towed, the owner shall be responsible for the reasonable cost of removal and storage prior to regaining possession of the same. Any ticket issued pursuant to this section shall be subject to the general penalty provision of the Code, Chapter 1, Article II, § 1-5, and a fine established in the sound discretion of the Municipal Court Judge.

Chapter 171. Streets and Sidewalks

Article I. General Regulations

§ 171-3. Snow, ice and dirt removal.

The owners of premises adjoining any sidewalk in the Township shall, within 10 hours after snow shall at any time have ceased falling, remove or cause to be removed from such sidewalk and gutter of the street all snow and ice thereon, and the occupant of any and all such adjoining premises shall remove or cause to be removed all dirt from the sidewalk and gutter of streets and from the highways and alleys of the Township.
