

VOLUNTEERS FOR THE SHOW AT THE MILL

Now that you've marked the dates on your calendar, it's time to think about volunteering to work at the show. From hanging the quilts to working at the boutique to white gloving, there are jobs suitable for all levels of fitness. Each work session lasts two hours, and job descriptions will be available. Sign-ups will begin at the June meeting in person and continue at our meetings and online. Participating in the show is one of the most joyful and memorable ways to be a part of Courthouse Quilters.

MINIS IN THE MILL

One of the successful fundraisers held during our CHQ biennial quilt show has been a raffle of mini quilts made by the guild members. The raffle is conducted in tricky-tray fashion, with the drawing on the afternoon of the last day of the show. It's a great opportunity for members, other quilters and non-quilters to take a chance at taking home a small piece(s) of quilted art made by CHQ members. In the past we've raffled 50-60 mini quilts per show.

Please consider making at least one Mini for our Courthouse Quilters Guild Show (September 30 - October 2). Here are the rules for Mini construction:

- 1. Your Mini can represent any theme and can be traditional, modern or an art quilt, either from a pattern or your own creation.
- 2. Your Mini can be as small as 6"x6" (minimum) or as large as 24"x24" (maximum).
- 3. No cheater cloth.
- 4. Your Mini can be machine or hand quilted; no tied quilts.
- 5. Your Mini should have a label with quilt title (optional), your name, county, state, date and Courthouse Quilters. That way the lucky winner will know all about their new quilt and who made it. It's not necessary to add a hanging sleeve.
- 6. Your Mini must be handed in by no later than the August meeting. This will give the committee time to photograph the Minis and finalize other details.


CHQ Members.

CHQ Board Meeting Agenda March 18, 2022 Meeting at 7 pm

Approve February's Board Minutes: 11 in favor, 0 opposed.

Old Business: Should all quilts entered into the 'Quilts In The Mill' show be charged a \$5 fee to cover show insurance, or should most quilts entered into the show be charge \$5, with the exception of quilts *requested* by the guild to promote guild's talent and examples of our workmanship; such as workshop or challenge guilts.

Motion to vote for all quilts other than quilts used to promote the guilds talents and workshops to be charged a \$5 acquisition fee. 11 in favor, 1 opposed.

Pizza Box Challenge Quilts will be charged \$5 for the series of mini quilts, other quilted collections will also be charged \$5 per series.

Baby quilts and member quilts will not be covered by show insurance. High valued quilts will need an appraisal and possibly additional insurance.
