EVENTS LEADING UP TO THE CATHOLIC CHURCH IN SAINT GEORGE

Part IV

In 1879, Father Scanlan received an invitation from the Mormon leaders in Saint George to celebrate a High Mass in the newly completed Saint George Tabernacle. John McFarland had much to do with obtaining permission for the Mass; in fact, he went all the way to Erastus Snow, a very senior Mormon authority to get formal consent. Father Scanlan thankfully accepted the gracious invitation, explained he did not have a choir for the Mass that was in Latin. So, Father Scanlan believed he would have to omit that particular part of the service. However, John MacFarland, the Mormon choir director asked for the Catholic music, "The Peter's Mass," and within two weeks the choir practiced and memorized the all of the required music in Latin. On May 18, 1779 the High Mass was perfectly celebrated with the appropriate music. Since most of the congregation was Mormon, Father Scanlan explained the significance of the sacred vestments and preached a very eloquent Over 3,000 people were in sermon. attendance. An unidentified French correspondent reported, "It was the grandest event I have ever witnessed in the history of the Catholic Church."
